Home Delivery Program Overview:

This program works to enable home bound elderly, disabled and medically fragile clients to continue to live independently. We pair clients with a qualified and screened volunteer who will deliver food, including non-perishables, produce, dairy, and meats on a bi-weekly or monthly basis to their homes. Every effort is made to provide food that will fit their health restrictions and dietary preferences.

Home Delivery Program Eligibility:

Low-income and homebound Morris County residents who are elderly and/or disabled and without transportation to one of the Interfaith Food Pantry Network locations are eligible for this program.

Each clients eligibility will be determined on a case-by-case basis during the home visit or phone interview


